1/13 **MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 4 DECEMBER 2012**

The minutes of the meeting held on 4 December 2012 were agreed and signed as a correct record.

2/13 **ELECTION OF A CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN FOR 2013**

Councillor Owen was elected as Chairman.  
Councillor Lowe was elected as Vice-Chairman.

3/13 **CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED**

There was no correspondence to report.

4/13 **EXISTING PROJECTS – PROGRERSS REPORT**

With regard to the Sports Legacy Project at Wheatley Lane Recreation Ground and the progress so far in obtaining the necessary funding it was reported that the bid made for £50,000 to Inspired Facilities had not been successful. It was suggested that this was because they did not understand the nature of the play equipment proposed. It was therefore decided to re-submit the bid on the basis that the project was for sports related equipment.

It was confirmed that the bid made to the Borough Council's Neighbourhood Fund in the sum of 20,000 had been successful in addition to the £5,000 grant from Consolidated Charities.

It was therefore agreed to consider proceeding on a phased basis, albeit this would be better once the result of the re-submitted bid was known.

The costs breakdown was as follows:

5/13 **FUTURE PROJECTS**

As part of a planting project future volunteers were required to do the initial pricking-out of young plants at the Horticultural Centre.

6/13 **FINANCIAL REPORT**

It was reported that the Youth Council currently has existing funds of £7,295.91.

7/13 **REPORT FROM OTHER ORGANISATIONS**

There were no matters to report from other organisations.

8/13 **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

Members considered what they thought to be good and bad in Winhill.

Problem areas identified were:

Stanhope Street	Litter, dog mess and rubble
Bearwood Hill	Glass, broken fence and abandoned house
Empire Road	Rubbish from gardens in road and vandalism
Top or Nelson Street Area	Parking on double yellow lines and empty pub
Ashby Road	Recent house fire

It was agreed that these problem areas be referred to the appropriate authorities for action.
