We have achieved the PLA gold award by working hard to meet all requirements, including providing healthy alternatives for the children at snacktime, opportunities for rhymes and singing and physical activities in all sessions. Users of our group receive information and ideas for fun activities which can be used to help their child with being healthy, talking and playing in a safe environment.
